You must obtain an official high school transcript by requesting this in writing from your high school. Have it sent directly to RCC Admissions or deliver in sealed envelope.

Need financial aid? Submit FAFSA on-line application early! See http://www.robeson.edu/financial_aid/

The FAFSA application may take weeks to process!

If you attended other colleges, you must have those official transcripts sent to RCC Admissions. Also SAT, AP, CLEP scores. We cannot award transfer credit without original documents. Only grades of C and above transfer in.

If you do not have SAT scores, or sufficient test credits, you will need to take placement tests. 272-3353

Many factors impact your award status. Take care of your RCC admissions process. READ YOUR MAIL & E-MAIL.*

Notification of acceptance? Congratulations! Follow any special instructions in the letter.

After 2 weeks, if you have not received a letter of acceptance, call RCC Admissions to check on your application status. 272-3342
